To help to thousands of women of limited resources in the metropolitan area, to reach an economic and emotional stability, is its slogan from its foundation in 1998. , after eight years now creating alliances and incorporating new organizations, the Foundation of Women of the Metropolitan Area of Washington DC, celebrate their profits and it was committed to continue working more by the needed communities. “We began as a small organization of volunteers and have grown considerably in all this time. We are it jeopardize with the diverse community of women and children of the metropolitan area, but we wished to have a greater presence between the communities immigrants”, indicates *to Washington Hispanic*, Nisha Patel, official of programs of the Foundation of Women of the Metropolitan Area.

At the same time, the foundation looks for to create conscience on the necessities that face the women and children of limited resources, for this way waking up the interest of the organizations and public and deprived institutions, so that they collaborate through donations and to obtain that it continues growing the network of resources and aid that is offered to the community.

Through the foundation the Latin organizations who benefit, among them are several are House of Maryland, Services of Council on Inc. House, AID, among others.

“Thanks to the economic support that gives the foundation us, we have developed a program to help the women who arrive until our center of use in search of a work. We trained them, we helped them to prepare his currículo, and we even advised them on the correct way to appear and to respond in a work interview”, counts Ana Kaminski, specialist of use of the Center of Workers of Wheaton de Casa of Maryland.

Through the multiple programs that the foundation sponsors, a saving, between the women to whom they serve, of 2.995,000 dollars has been obtained, 114 women has increased its income, has improved its financial situation, has reduced its debts by a total of 72,324 dollars and collectively it has served more than 7,903 women through services of financial education, customized council, classes and training on leadership, among others.
