#### **MISSION**

Washington Area Women's Foundation is a community-supported foundation that invests in the power of women and girls of color in the Washington, D.C. region.

All proceeds from the 2025 Celebration of Women and Girls will support Washington Area Women's Foundation's mission.

Since 1998, we have awarded more than \$17 million in grants to more than 215 local community-based organizations and individuals.

#### **HISTORY**

The Washington Area Women's Foundation was built on the belief that women, united in purpose, can drive lasting change to improve the physical, social, and financial well-being of women and girls. Inspired by the growing "women's funding movement" across the United States and recognizing a critical need for Washington, D.C., a group of visionary women took action. What began as a simple invitation to an afternoon tea soon blossomed into a powerful movement. that evolved into what we proudly know today as Washington Area Women's Foundation.

### **Maternal Health & Birth Equity Initiative**

Every mother deserves a safe and supported birthing experience. We invest in community-driven solutions to dismantle racial disparities in maternal health and ensure that every birthing person has access to equitable care and resources.

## **Early Care and Education**

To advance Early Care and Education we house the Early Care and Education Funder's Collaborative (ECEFC), connecting funders and facilitating learning, action, and philanthropy. The ECEFC funds advocacy and grassroots organizations to increase the quality and capacity of and access to early care and education in the Washington, D.C. region.

## **Young Women's Initiative**

The Young Women's Initiative (YWI) is a national initiative of prominent women's foundations to ensure all young women—particularly young women of color—lead, prosper economically, and live safe and healthy lives. We put young people at the helm of advancing solutions to the problems they encounter in their lives and communities to advance gender equity and racial justice in DC and surrounding regions.

## **Black Women's Leadership Project**

Black women nonprofit leaders face systemic challenges that hinder their success. The Black Women's Leadership Project (BWLP), inspired by our Thrive As They Lead report, addresses these barriers by strengthening the sector's infrastructure to ensure it is meeting their needs.
